Minimum Requirements:

- 1. Work cannot encroach on a zoning setback
- 2. Addition of patio, service walk, or stoop must not surpass maximum level of impervious surface coverage as outlined in the zoning ordinance.
- 3. Work cannot obstruct or alter the flow of stormwater.
- 4. Stoops must be at least 36" wide or the width of the door, whichever is greater. The stoop must also be at least 36" deep.

Minimum Requirements (Cont'd):

- 5. For concrete:
 - A. 4" compacted gravel base or equivalent, free of organic matter.
 - B. For patios: Construction joints required with a maximum spacing of 12 feet in each direction.
 - C. Wire mesh, fiber mesh, or equivalent required for crack control.
 - D. Concrete must be protected from freezing, rain, and dehydration per code and accepted industry standards.
 - E. 4 inch thick concrete slab.
 - F. Minimum 6 bag cement mix.
 - G. Expansion joints required against buildings and existing concrete.
 - H. Concrete stoops shall have two #4 rebar pinned to the foundation to connect the stoop if possible.
 - I. Stoops built against non-cementious shall include flashing.
- 6. For brick or stone pavers:
 - A. 6 inch compacted gravel sub-base with 1 inch sand base on top, or equivalent.
 - B. Pavers shall not be less than 2 3/8 inches thick.
- 7. All walking surfaces must be pitched away from structures.
- 8. The maximum single step riser height is 7 3/4 inches.
- 9. The minimum single step tread depth is 10 inches.
- 10. All steps must be of uniform dimensions and not present a tripping hazard.
- 11. Handrails are required for more than 3 step risers.
- 12. Good workmanship is required per accepted industry standards.
- 13. All broken out concrete must be hauled off site and disposed of properly.
- 14. For public sidewalk replacement, contact the Village's Public Works Department.
- 15. Permit fees: \$35 for patios, \$20 for walkways and stoops, payable at time of permit issuance

Schedule Inspections With:

- 1. Base inspection (Prior to pouring of concrete or brick installation.)
- 2. Final inspection
