20.02.030 Village exempt from fees.

The Village of Carpentersville shall be exempt from the payment of all fees in this Chapter, including but not limited to all ambulance service fees, liquor license fees, business license fees, vehicle registration fees, streets and sidewalks fees, water and sewer fees, building permit fees, fire prevention fees, sign permit fees, land use filing fees, administration fees, police services fees, garbage collection fees, and emergency response fees.
