



In 2015 **10,265** people died in an alcohol related crash. That is 29% of all traffic related deaths.

A first offense DUI in Illinois entails both criminal penalties and prolonged license reinstatement process upon conviction. Note, the State of Illinois estimates that the total cost of a first time DUI (including raised insurance rates, temporary loss of income, court costs and other expenses at **\$16,000**).

In fatal crashes, **33%** of drivers with BAC levels of .08 or higher were drivers between the ages of **21-24**, followed by drivers between the ages of **25-34 (29%)**.
